Coaches “Race Day” Information

Team Parking

All team bus parking will be at Fort St. Clair Park. Teams may bring their bus into the park entrance and *drop off athletes / coaches at the designated drop off/pick-up area only* (see attachment entitled – Coaches Park Specifics). Your driver may then take the bus through the park to one of the designated parking areas in the lower part of the park. Once your races are completed you may bring your bus back to the pick-up area (same as the drop-off location) to load your team and equipment.

Team Camp Areas

All teams should be only in the designated areas with team set-up. Please make sure you stay well off any area of the course. The designated team areas are color coded (see attachment titled – Coaches Park Specifics).

Spectator Parking

Handicapped and parking for the elderly will be available in a limited quantity in the park, only in designated areas. All other spectator parking will be at Eaton High School. Eaton Community Schools will run a yellow school shuttle bus from the high school to the park entrance, approximately ¼ mile from the park, starting at 7:30 a.m. and running until 3:30 p.m.. The bus pick up will be on the North side parking lot at the school and drop off at the park entrance and run in the reverse order for spectators to return to the school. Those who wish to walk may walk the short distance to the park along the paved walking path and sidewalk which will run down to the park entrance. Police officers will control the flow of traffic into and out of the park while directing spectators to the designated parking areas. Cars should not park in the cemetery, across from the park or Whisper Way, a private community just down from the park. **More than sufficient parking (over 500 spots at the high school alone) exists – just plan ahead! Please notify your parents regarding parking prior to race day! This will help everyone!**

Race Day Miscellaneous

- 1.) Pick up race packets/information at the registration area located by the finish line.
- 2.) Additional course maps will be available on race day in your team packet.
- 3.) If you have any questions please ask at the registration area upon arrival.
- 4.) All runners will wear a race tag, on front of their jersey, in all races. Make sure you give each athlete his/her correct assigned tag.
- 5.) Please help us by following the parking and team camp guidelines.
- 6.) Make sure you clean up your camp area prior to departure. To the Eaton Cross Country program and the community Fort St. Clair Park is a true treasure. Please help us keep it clean by doing your part prior to leaving the park.
